





We ask that you consider the following;

You are probably aware that there have been several fruit fly outbreaks in the Riverland.

When this happens the authorities designate areas around the site of the outbreak with those closest – the **"Red"** area - being subject to the strictest rules for fruit movement.

RESTRICTIONS HAVE BEEN EXTENDED 'TIL DECEMBER 22, 2024

NB: there is up to \$100,000 fines for Non Compliance.

This means:

ANYONE TAKING *RESTRICTED* FRUIT FROM THE CHURCH CAN BE FINED




The board has updated the key policy. Anyone with a church key must also have a WWCC clearance.
