

#### Dear church family at Living Waters

Humble greetings to you all in the name of Jesus Christ our Lord and Master, As you are praying for us, our families are doing well, our missions works are in preparation for the Christmas Season Gospel Activities with the vision of reaching the 2000 orphan children for the upcoming 3 months in 13 villages, praying for the need of Shoe boxes to be given as our ongoing project Christmas Joy to Leper's children, Ragpickers families children etc.

As you know that early September we had destructive floods and our churches drowned and everything was destroyed in the floods.... Again, we praise God as we are trying to build a 75 feet long and 25 feet wider Community Church for the 'Untouchable' and downtrodden people called "DALITS" and Tribals families. Please pray the Lord would complete it by Dec 25 and it be dedicated for God's glory: At least roof and floor, drinking water and electricity etc. This will be meeting their worship gatherings and Ragpickers children and the underprivileged children's primary teaching needs with the Biblical stories in shaping them spiritually.






