



Behavioural Management Procedure 2025

REACHarge Youth seeks to provide an environment where everyone is valued and treated with care, compassion, and respect. We ask parents/caregivers and participants to acknowledge the following behavioural management steps:

STEP 1 – WARNING

The participant will be asked to stop inappropriate behaviour (disruptive or unwanted behaviour) as this detracts from the group's activities and dynamics.

STEP 2 – TIME OUT

If the inappropriate behaviour continues, the participant will be removed from the group until their behaviour improves. They will return to the group when the leadership team deems it appropriate.

STEP 3 – PHONE HOME

If the inappropriate behaviour still continues, the leadership team will contact the participant's parents/caregivers and inform them of their youth's behaviour and what action has been taken. They will then be asked to take their youth home.

STEP 4 – EXCLUSION

The participant will be excluded from subsequent events as determined by what the leadership team deems appropriate, the youth and their parents/caregivers will be made aware of why this has happened and the expectations for future behaviour.

AGGRESSIVE BEHAVIOUR

Aggressive behaviour will not be tolerated. If a participant engages in any form of aggressive behaviour including physical and verbal, their parents/caregivers will be contacted and be asked to take them home immediately.
